Artist and Teacher Kittie Yohe Featured in June Community Gallery Exhibit at YMCA

Northbrook, IL: June 2017 – The colorful artwork of veteran teacher Kittie Yohe will be showcased in a wide-ranging exhibit at the North Suburban YMCA's Community Gallery during the month of June. The public is welcome to tour the free exhibit at the Y, located at 2705 Techny Road in Northbrook, beginning on June 2.

Kittie Yohe, a Northbrook resident, has been painting watercolors for 41 years. She has exhibited in local art fairs and participated in both one-woman and group shows. Her work is represented in many private collections. She is a member of the Glenview Art League and most recently studied watercolor with the late Jean Poklop.

Kittie paints a variety of subject matter, usually flora and fauna. Her nature-based paintings are completed in series, each emphasizing a theme. In recent years, Kittie has been experimenting with a synthetic Japanese paper, YUPO, and various mixed media.

Now retired, Kittie was an art educator for 35 years, including many years in Northbrook's District 28 schools. She received her Bachelor's degree in Art Education from Miami University and her Master's degree in the same field from the University of Illinois.

The YMCA's Community Gallery presents monthly exhibits from talented artists living and working in the northern suburbs. Artwork exhibited in the Community Gallery is available for purchase, with a portion of sale proceeds supporting the Y's Visual Arts Programs.
