Red Cross Babysitting Course Babysitting Basics

Recommended for those ages 11 to 18 years old, this course is designed to help participants develop leadership skills, build their business, help keep themselves and others safe, help children learn how to behave, and learn basic child care and basic first aid. Students who successfully complete the course will receive a certificate. Students should bring a lunch and pen/pencil to class. Students who successfully complete this class are encouraged to volunteer in Child Watch to help gain experience with children.

All students will receive a Babysitter Training Participant Set. The Babysitter Training Participant's Set includes an assortment of materials to better assist babysitters on the job, such as the: Babysitter's Training Handbook, Babysitter's Training Emergency Reference Guide, and Babysitter's Training CD-ROM, which provides participants with the tools they will need to run their own babysitting business, including a babysitting organizer; a printable activity booklet with games, crafts, songs and recipes; a resume template; and more.

ADULT AND PEDIATRIC FIRST AID/CPR/AED CERTIFICATION

The Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED course teaches students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid emergencies such as burns, cuts, scrapes, sudden illnesses, head, neck, back injuries, heat and cold emergencies and how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age - adults (about 12 years and older) and pediatric (infants and children up to 12 years of age). Students who successfully complete this course will receive a certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED valid for two years. Students will attend one day of training. Students who are not currently certified must attend the new certification class. Students who have a current certification, may attend the recertification class. Payment of class fees does not guarantee certification.
