Lifeguard Blended Learning Class

Learn the skills and knowledge required to become an American Red Cross lifeguard, including how to recognize, prevent and respond quickly to aquatic emergencies. Learn CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, and First Aid. This course incorporates in-person, in-water, and online components.

Lifeguard Review Class

The Red Cross Lifeguard Review course is intended for current lifeguards trying to re-certify. Review the skills and knowledge including how to recognize, prevent and respond quickly to aquatic emergencies. Including CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, and First Aid. This course incorporates in-person and in-water skills. Participants must have a current American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification or recently expired certification.

Cost: \$150 for NSYMCA Member/ \$200 for NM
